Conditional Use Permit Application

Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in obtaining a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) through the Town Of Rudolph, WI. We would like you be aware of the following information during this process to make the procedure run smoothly.

In general, conditional use permits are needed when changing the use of land (for example, mining, starting a business, keeping more than three dogs or building other than residences or agricultural structures).

Conditional use applications must be submitted to the Land Use and Zoning Commission chair by **December 10, April 10 or August 10**, to qualify for the regularly scheduled hearings, held the **second Wednesday of January, May and September**. * Special meetings may be called for at other times, however, the applicant(s) must pay \$225 plus the publication fee of \$35.

At the zoning hearing, the commission decides whether to recommend the conditional use permit to the town board, and any recommended restrictions. We strongly encourage applicants and landowners to attend the meeting where your Conditional Use Permit is being presented to answer any further questions that might arise. The Town Board will then act upon the recommendation at the next monthly town board meeting.
